There will be a dockside parties at the Marina both Friday and Saturday evenings. Activities around Shelter Cove includes biking, kayaking, dolphin watching, fishing, shopping or a trip to the beach. There are 9 restaurants in the Marina area to choose from for dinner Saturday night.
