On the 19th, we held our 2017 Kick-Off Party and had a great turnout. We had around 100 attendees and it really was a fabulous get together thanks to Linda Dew, Paulette Hamilton, Amy Collings and their large team of volunteers - all of whom helped make the party memorable.

That night, I went over our 2017 plans, recapped below:

- I. Continue with many of the same successful events as last year including Dock Parties, Tall Tales by the Fire, The Burning of the Socks, Oktoberfest, and boat trips to restaurants to name just a sampling. Of course, we will have a return trip to Daufuskie Island in 2017!
- 2. Expand the Low Country Hook Ocean Race for 2017, by attracting more boats and sponsors. Last year was a record setting event for Savannah and this year we hope it will be even bigger. The Hook is scheduled for July, coordinated with other area racing events.
- 3. Get more boats involved in cruising. The first event is planned for April Fool's Day: a trip to Hilton Head Shelter Cover Marina for 1 or 2 nights. If you don't have a boat with overnight capabilities, invite yourself along with another boat owner or check into the overnight accommodations available at Palmetto Dunes. More information is included on our CALENDAR and more details will be coming out.

- 5. Bring a greater awareness of SIBC and boating opportunities to the residents and potential residents of The Landings.
- 6. Continue to strengthen our relationship with TLA.
- 7. Continue searching for a "Watering Hole", similar to the old Captains' Lounge, to serve as an informal meeting place on the water to "tip a few" and discuss boating.
