The club has just finished a social activities survey of members asking what their


boating and social activity preferences would be in 2023 and the results of the survey is published below. The results are very interesting.

SIBC Social Event Survey Results

All our members were given an opportunity to express their preferences for several social events that the club is considering in 2023. The events that we are considering are listed below:

- 1) A visit to Grey's Reef Discovery Center in Downtown Savannah,
- 2) A sail on a Rhodes 19 with the Landings Sailing Club with an experienced sailor,
- 3) A Kayak tour on Ebenezar Creek with an experience guide...probably in the Spring,
- 4) Carefree pop up trips with some of our Carefree members,
- 5) A restaurant trip to Thunderbolt with the restaurant to be determined,
- 6) A trip to Daufuskie Island this would be a day trip, pontoon boat to the island and golf cart tours of the island
- 7) Lunch on Wassaw Island with Carefree Boats
- 8) A trip on the Savannah Queen including lunch probably 2 ½ hours
- 9) A boating visit to Ft Jackson, then lunch on River Street in Savannah
- 10) A Speaker for the winter months (example UGA Marine Studies CCA and Tiny Houses Project etc..)

We received 37 responses which is a good sampling of our club membership. Each member could check as many events as they were interested in. Here are the results:



The top five choices of our members were:

- 1) A trip to Daufuskie Island 75.7%
- 2) Lunch on Wassaw Island 73%
- 3) Carefree Pop up Boat Trips 70.3%
- 4) A visit to Grey's Reef Discovery Center 64.9%
- 5) A Kayak tour of Ebanezar Creek 59.5%

I wanted to Thank all those participating in the Social Event Survey. As our Social Committee plans out 2023 events for our membership, this will help us make informed decisions about what you would like to participate in. More on this later...


